Cornerstone Christian Counseling is looking for a qualified, faith-based counselor who would like to join our practice in a part- to full-time capacity. The right applicant will...

- Have state licensure or be pursuing state licensure in the mental health field (LMFT or LPC – sorry, no LCSW's, pastoral or biblical counselors, or coaches).
- Have experience working with couples, children, families and individuals. Preference will be given to applicants with specialties in play therapy (PCIT, Synergetic Play Therapy, etc) substance abuse and/or addictions (CAC classes, certification or licensure), trauma (EMDR or BSP) or other specific modalities such as Emotionally-Focused Therapy.
- Be available for weekly group case consultation meetings via Zoom, currently scheduled for Wednesdays from 9-11 a.m. (this is non-negotiable).
- Manage your time well. It is imperative you are punctual, reliable and timely.
- Be available at least 15 hours per week to start. Your schedule will need to include two consistent days/evenings each week (until 9 p.m.) **or** one day/evening and one Saturday.
- Be willing to see up to 50% of your caseload in-person during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Have a private, virtual home office that you are comfortable working from for the remaining 50% of your caseload.
- Understand that our model is a blend between a group and private practice. There are opportunities for autonomy, but a go-it-alone attitude won't work here. We work together as a team and are constantly working towards improving ourselves individually and as a group.

As an employee with Cornerstone Christian Counseling, you get to choose the days/hours you would like to work, and have the freedom and flexibility to control

your schedule. However, you also acquire new clients only as the phone rings; this is not a salaried position and a set number of clients from week to week is not guaranteed.

- Attractive fee split – our unlicensed clinicians make up to \$38/hr; licensed clinicians can make anywhere from \$57.50/hr to \$96.25/hr, DOE.
- If licensed with 5 years of experience or more, opportunities for Supervisory roles exist. Supervisory work pays our normal fee split per hour.
- Leadership opportunities within our practice also exist and are paid at \$30/hr.
- Annual stipend for continuing education (\$200/yr)
- Fully furnished, comfortable offices and waiting rooms
- A secure, HIPAA-compliant Zoom account
- A secure, HIPAA-compliant EHR account
- Weekly continuing education and training opportunities
- Full-time office support staff to help you with any and all administrative tasks
- Marketing support to help you grow and maintain your caseload
- Group and individual malpractice coverage
- Regular team building events
- Ministry and volunteer opportunities
- Accrual of paid time off (PTO) (coming in 2021)
- Unlicensed clinicians are assigned to a Supervisor on our team, ensuring all supervisory requirements for full licensure in the state of CO are met
- Licensed clinicians are assigned to a member of our Leadership Team for ongoing peer consultation and support
